Presidents


Abraham Lincoln

- Believed in liberty and quality as seen in his speeches, i.e. Gettysburg Address and Second Inaugural
- Leader of Republican Party
- Assassinated in 1865



Jefferson Davis

- U.S. soldier during the Mexican War
- Senator from Mississippi
- President of the Confederate States of America during the Civil War



Generals


Ulysses S. Grant

- · Leading U.S. general during the Civil War
- · Victor at the Battle of Vicksburg
- Accepted Lee's surrender at Appomattox to end Civil War
- President of the U.S. during
 Reconstruction



Robert E. Lee

- U.S. soldier during the Mexican War
- Leading general for the Confederacy
- Surrendered to Ulysses Grant that ended the Civil war
